

It is hoped that as many as possible will transfer from the envelope system to the Parish Giving Scheme, giving by direct debit rather than cash or cheques, particularly where Gift Aid is involved. This enables us to know how much money is coming in, means Gift Aid can be collected direct, and there is not so much cash for Gyl and Jane to count after services. A simple phone call or email can increase or decrease donations as required.
