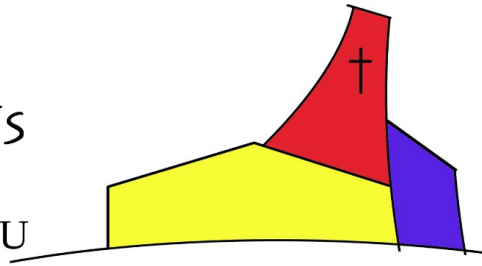

SCLERDER ABBEY FAMILY FESTIVAL

This beautiful abbey is set in the countryside on the Cornish Celtic Way between Looe and Polperro and has been run for over 150 years by various nuns, being largely closed to and from the outside world. Three years ago, it was given to the Chemin Neuf Community with the hope that it could be used as a centre for all Christians.

A Family Festival will be held there on 19th August from 10am – 10pm in celebration of this, organised by the Truro Diocese, Churches Together Cornwall, Celebrate Torquay and the Catholic Diocese of Plymouth. It will include indoor and outdoor activities, arts and crafts workshops, sports, evening barbecue, live worship band and a historical tour of the Abbey.

Family tickets are £20 with single tickets at £10, including packed lunches, but the Abbey is keen to help those for whom money might be an issue. See Rosey or Shirley for more details or Google Sclerder Abbey.

Medical supplies going to Syria

You may notice a rather large container in our carpark. That's because local volunteers and organisations have worked together to gather old medical supplies from Treliske and elsewhere, (that would otherwise be disposed of), are being collected this weekend for delivery to Syrian hospitals. The charity behind this is Syria Relief and the donations gathered will be making their way to Idlib and Sarmada in North West Syria, just west of Aleppo.
