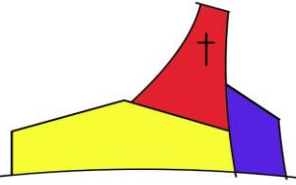

Thankfully that wasn't necessary but he did need to wear an arm sleeve for 23 ^{1/2} hours a day to help the skin heal flat. They thought he would need to wear it for 2 years but a year
